Fees:

- Application Fee \$35.00 (New students)
- Re-enrollment Fee \$25.00 (Returning students) ٠
- \*Registration Fee -\$350 due by July 31, 2025, not covered by Opportunity or Constituent Scholarships. ۲

Discounts:

- 2% discount is available if the semester is paid in full by Orientation Day or by January 5th, 2026.
- 4% discount is available if the full year is paid by Orientation Day

Scholarships:

- NCSEAA awards Opportunity Scholarship (OPS) according to eligibility tier and is applied to Tuition, Technology, and Textbook Fees.
- Constituent Church Scholarships are available through constituent churches and are awarded up to \$1,800.00 towards tuition. ٠
- Financial Aid is available through an application and will be applied toward tuition. Please see the business manager for • details on the application process.
- All the tuition charges listed above are distributed over 10 months, from August to May, and are due on the 1st of each month. A late fee of \$30.00 will apply if the bill is paid after the 15th of the month.
- If necessary, textbook and technology fees can be modified to align with the ten-month payment schedule. •
- Families should collaborate with the business manager to establish a financial agreement and payment plan.
