Fees:

- Application Fee - \$35.00 (New students)
- Re-enrollment Fee - \$25.00 (Returning students)
- \*Registration Fee -\$350 (\$250 due by April 30, 2026) to secure student seats, with the balance (\$100) due by June 15, 2026
- **All registration fees are non-refundable** and not covered by Opportunity or Constituent Scholarships.

Discounts:

- A 2% discount is available if the semester is paid in full by Orientation Day (August 4th) or by January 4th, 2027.
- A 4% discount is available if the full year is paid by Orientation Day (August 4th)

Scholarships:

- NCSEAA awards the Opportunity Scholarship (OPS) based on eligibility tier and applies it to Tuition, Technology, and Textbook Fees.
- Constituent Church Scholarships are available through constituent churches and are awarded up to \$1,800.00 towards tuition.
- Financial Aid is available through an application and will be applied toward tuition. Please see the business manager for details on the application process.
- All the tuition charges listed above are distributed over 10 months, from August to May, and are due on the 1st of each month. A \$30.00 late fee will apply if the bill is paid after the 15th of the month.
- If necessary, textbook and technology fees can be modified to align with the ten-month payment schedule.
- Families should collaborate with the business manager to establish a financial agreement and payment plan.
